The medical home approach to health care



Health care delivered through a medical home is accessible, patient-centered, personalized, comprehensive, coordinated, compassionate and culturally responsive.

What is a Medical Home?

A medical home is not a place. It is a way to help you make sure all of your individual and/or family's health care needs are met. The medical home approach looks at the whole person, taking into consideration all medical, dental and mental/emotional health and community-based needs. With a medical home approach to health care, your ideas, concerns, culture and values are respected. Medical home is the "new, old-fashioned care" - a partnership between you and your health care providers.

If you would like your health care delivered through a medical home approach, talk to your providers to learn if they provide care in this way.

Questions to Ask Your Providers

- Do you consider yourself a medical home?
- How is care delivered through a medical home different from the care I receive now?
- How do you communicate with my other doctors?
- Can you help me find other services I might need?

Managing Your Health Information

- Keep your health information together in one location, such as a folder, notebook or flash drive. Include:
 - Your doctors' names and phone numbers
 - Allergies, including drug allergies
 - Medications, vitamins and herbal supplements you take, plus dosages
 - Chronic health problems
 - Surgeries and hospitalizations, with dates
 - Cholesterol levels, blood pressure readings, and lab test, x-ray and screening results, with dates
 - Living will or advance directives
- Bring your health information to each doctor visit along with a list of questions you may have.
- At all times carry a card with your vital information on it, such as medication needs or allergies.
- Allow your doctor to share your health information with your other doctors and health care providers when necessary. You may need to fill out a permission form.
